

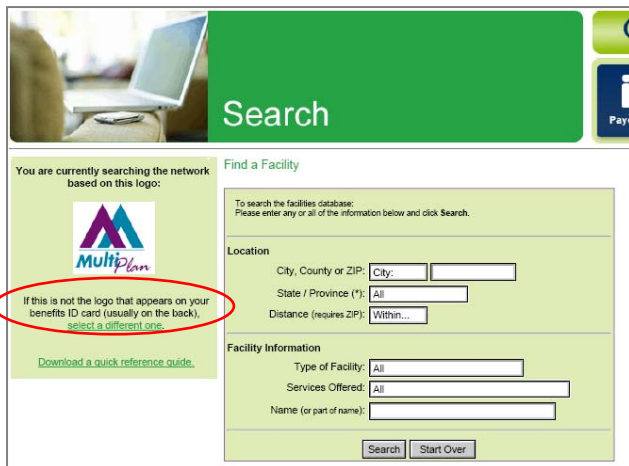
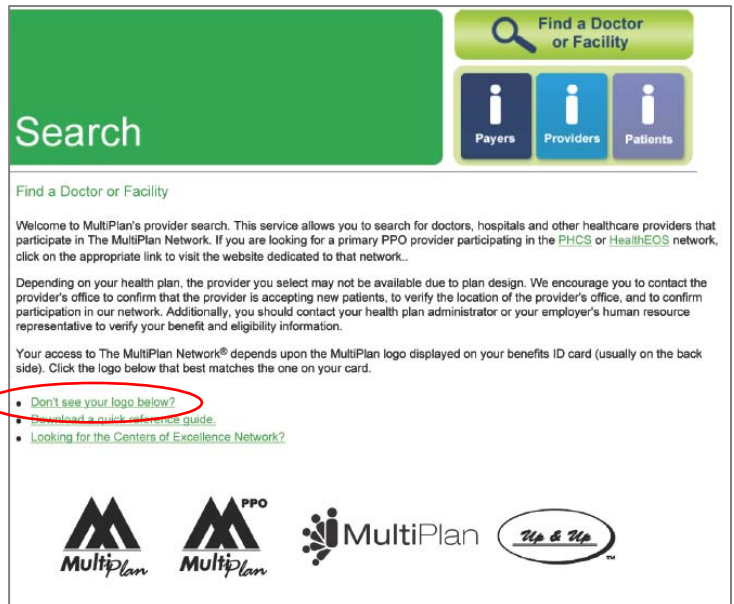

Find a MultiPlan Provider ... Online

Step 1: Go to www.multiplan.com and select Find a Doctor or Facility from the home page (or any website page).

Step 2: If this is your first time searching the network, you will be asked to select a logo from the screen that matches the logo shown on your ID card. If you don't see your logo in the first selection, click where it says "Don't see your logo?" If you don't see your logo on the next screen, click where it says "Still don't see your logo?"

If you have already completed a previous search, the logo you selected will be used as the default (shown on the left side of the screen). If you need to change this, you may do so by clicking on the hyperlink [select a different one](#).



Step 3: Select the type of provider you wish to search (facility or practitioner). You will be presented with a disclaimer and asked to acknowledge that you accept it.

Step 4: Enter your search parameters. You can search by location, by distance from your location, by specialty or services offered, and by full or partial name.

Step 5: Click Search and you will see a list of providers matching your request. Click on the provider name to learn more, print details and even get a map.

You can make up to five searches, and then will be asked to establish a username and password for unlimited future searches. This information is never shared with anyone.

Call the MultiPlan toll free referral line, 800-672-2140 any time, day or night. A service representative will perform the search for you and give you the results over the telephone.

Before You Go

It is your responsibility to confirm the providers' continued participation in the network, and their availability under your benefit plan. Please also be sure to follow any preauthorization procedures required by your plan (usually a telephone number on your ID card). In addition, to ensure proper handling of your claim, always present your current benefits ID card upon arrival at your appointment.
